Dear Cleveland Central Catholic School Community,

COVID Notification and Home Study Day on Friday, September 17, 2021

We received word that **one** member of the football team and **one** member of the cross country team have tested positive for COVID. We are handling this situation swiftly and with an abundance of caution in order to take steps to keep our school community as safe as possible.

Because we require masks for all students during the school day, the quarantine policy will apply only to team members and coaches. Following CDC guidelines, because practices are conducted without masks, all team members and coaches must quarantine immediately for 10 days. However, if a student or coach is symptom free, the student or coach may get a COVID test on SATURDAY or any day THEREAFTER. Cross country team members may test Wednesday (tomorrow) or any day thereafter.

Once test results are available, the results must be submitted to the school nurse via email (dbeane@ccc-hs.org), fax (216-641-2045), or hand delivered by someone who is not quarantined. If the COVID test results are negative, the student may return to school at that time and bring the negative test result paperwork with him/her.

Football players and cross country team members may obtain classwork through Google Classroom.

Tonight, we will use the Clorox 360 sanitizing unit to **sanitize all classrooms, offices, and common areas of the building**. This process will be completed again on Friday, September 17, 2021.

On Friday, September 17, 2021 we will have a **home study day** because 10 staff members will be absent for various reasons (not COVID related) and we do not have the capacity to cover that many classes. Teachers will provide assignments to students on Thursday and will post them in Google Classroom.

Because our shipment of chromebooks was delayed, we do not have chromebooks to issue to students at this time. Every effort will be made to assist students to make up any missed school work on their return to school.

Thank you for your understanding as we continue to navigate the waters of a global pandemic.
